The first annual report, that covering the legislation for 1916, appeared in 1917, and the report for the year 1917 was published during the summer of 1918. The material for the present volume has been selected from the latest Revised Statutes, from the subsequent yearly volumes of statutes up to the end of 1915, and in the case of Quebec from the Civil Code and the Code of Civil Procedure. For Alberta it was necessary to use the Consolidated Ordinances of the Northwest Territories,...
